

Four Operations: Addition and Subtraction

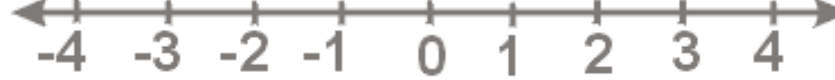
THE OPPOSITES OF

*Tips: Always visualize the answer in terms of the number line to avoid careless mistakes. Let the first number be the position and the second number be the number you shift.
